Anchorage

Ship's going to anchor must call « Dunkerque Pilot » on VHF 72 **two hours before and one hour before entering the waiting area** to get informations about traffic and anchorage position.

Pilot by helicopter

Informations to be transmitted to Dunkerque Pilot Radar Station on VHF 72:

> Ship's position.

> Course and speed.

- > Horizontal visibility.
- > Position of clear winching / landing area.

Ship's requirements:

- By night, all deck lights must be switched on.
- Nobody on the landing area.
- Radar on stand-by.
- > A wind indicator or a flag shall be flown.
- Fire fighting installations and equipment shall be ready.
- > All tank washing operations stopped.
- All tank opening and valves will remain closed.

Extra services

For ships leaving **DUNKERQUE**, pilot can be disembarked by **helicopter** at **NORD RUYTINGEN BUOY** or **MPC BUOY**. Ask for informations to your pilot. For ships on arrival, other Pilot Boarding Point may be planned with us through your agent.
